



Employment Opportunity – Maintenance Superintendent

Nunatsiavut Marine Inc. (NMI) is seeking a person to fulfil a Maintenance Superintendent position on a seasonal basis in Lewisporte, NL. NMI currently operates 2 service contracts with the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador for the Labrador Marine Service. The successful candidate would be responsible for, but not limited to, the following specific duties:

Responsibilities:

- Schedules and performs routine maintenance and repairs (electrical, hydraulic, mechanical) on all shore-based equipment, including vehicles, forklifts, yard tractors, trailers, gensets, containers, and container handlers;
- Provides facility maintenance support as required, including, but not limited to, garage doors, office entrance ways, fencing and gates, etc.;
- Performs repairs and provides support for equipment failures during critical and non-critical periods of operation, and ensures a prompt and safe return to service of equipment removed due to failure;
- Arranges and supports third party service providers in cases where assistance or specialized expertise is required;
- Maintains detailed records of repairs and maintenance performed on each piece of equipment, including parts, materials, and labor;
- Maintains a master list of all equipment and assets, tracking the location and operating condition of each item;
- Receives maintenance requests from operators and ensures that all requests are followed up and properly documented through completion;
- Ensures adherence to all safety legislation and industry standards to ensure that equipment is safe to operate and in compliance with Workplace Health and Safety regulations;

Qualifications:

- Heavy duty mechanic (diesel mechanic) license would be an asset;
- Minimum of 5 years' experience in an industrial setting where primary duty involved mechanical maintenance and repairs;
- Must demonstrate knowledge of diesel powered engines and equipment and a high degree of mechanical aptitude – able to diagnose problems and identify practical fixes;
