Reporting to the Second Engineer, the 3rd/4th Class Engineer performs their watch keeping duties from the Main Control Room. During their watch, they are responsible for the assisting with the maintenance, operation and repair as well as with ongoing planned and corrective maintenance and repair activities as required to safely keep the ship operating.

Responsibilities:

- Safely operate electrical, mechanical and hydraulic control systems, starting main engines, auxiliary engines, emergency equipment, lifeboat engines, thrusters, purifiers, cranes(if qualified), pumps etc. as required to prepare the ship for sea.
- As part of the watchkeeping duties, monitor and record the functioning parameters of the engine room equipment, main engines, auxiliary engines, boilers, pumps, and HVAC systems (pressure, temperature, levels) and report and or correct any irregularity as required.
- Carry out equipment maintenance from the planned preventative maintenance system as directed by the Second Engineer.
- Assist other shipboard departments as required. (life boats, galley equipment etc.)
- Maintain the applicable sections of the engine room logbook and work book as necessary.
- Keeps engine room and workshop tidy, wipes up oil spills, keeps tools and equipment secured or put away
- Performs other duties as directed by Second or Chief Engineer.
